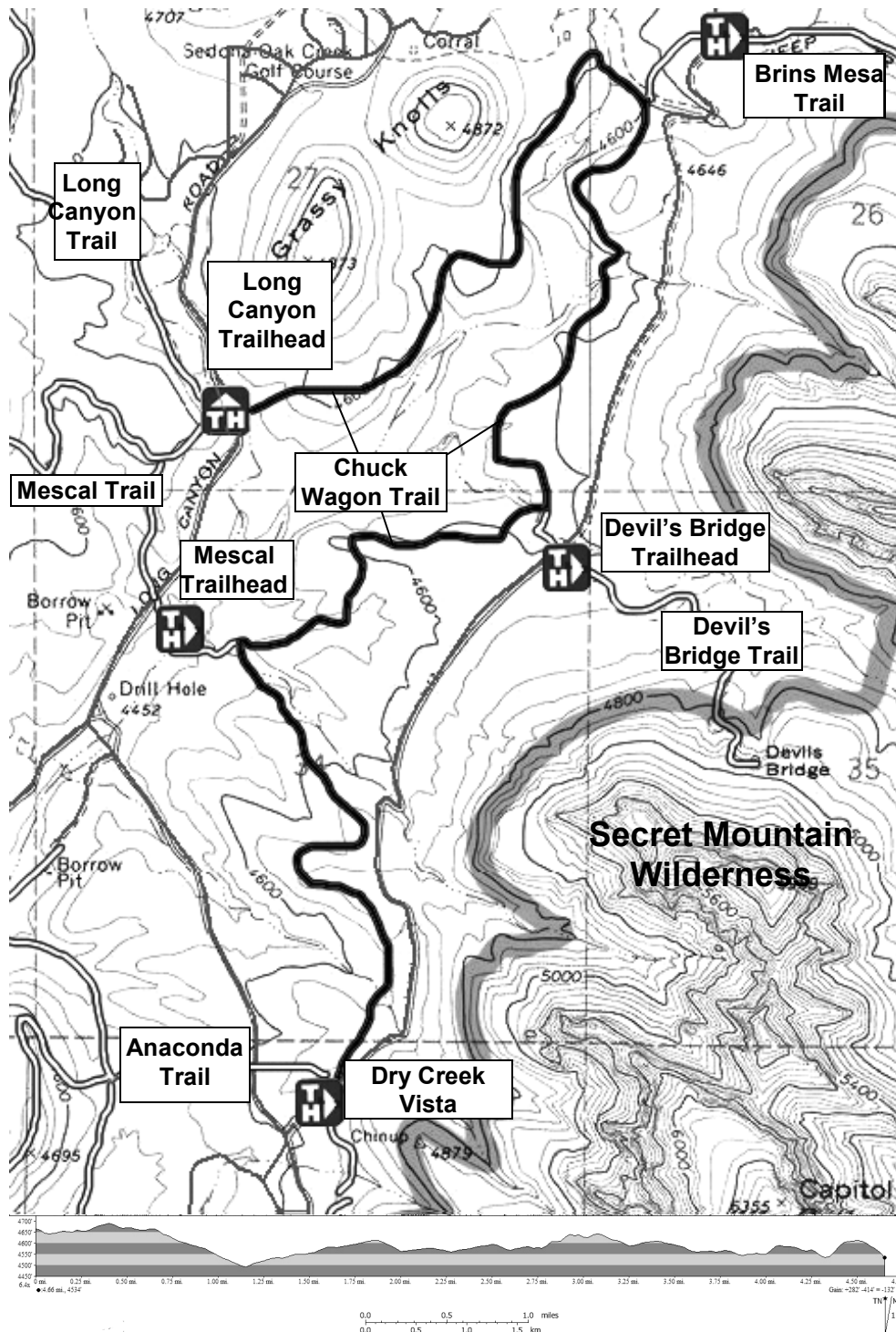


# Coconino National Forest Trail Guide - Chuckwagon Trail



Length: 4.6 miles one-way

3.8 miles one-way to the Brins Mesa Trailhead

2.1 miles one way to the Devil's Bridge Trailhead

Rating: Easy

Use: Hiking and Biking

Season: Year round

Hiking time: Allow 3.5 hours one way

Cumulative Elevation: 415 ft.

USGS Maps: Sedona.

Location: 31 miles south of Flagstaff in scenic Red Rock Country

Notes: Please stay on the trail to help protect fragile soils and plants, and preserve the area's natural splendor. Respect private property boundaries.

Cyclists: No bikes permitted in the Wilderness area. Please control your speed at all times and be prepared to stop quickly. Expect to find someone on the trail around every corner. Remember, it is the cyclist's responsibility to yield to all other trail users.

**Chuckwagon Trail:** Connects Dry Creek Vista (Chuckwagon Trailhead) with the Long Canyon Trail Head and provides access to the Devil's Bridge Trailhead from either Dry Creek Vista on Dry Creek Road (2.1 miles) or from the Mescal Trailhead on Long Canyon Road (1.2 miles). This trail is popular with mountain bikers and has nice views of the Red Rock Secret Mountain Wilderness area

**Chuckwagon/Mescal Extension Trail:** This trail provides a 0.2 mile connection between the Mescal Trailhead and the Chuckwagon Trail. The extension meets the Chuckwagon Trail at a point about 1.1 mile from Dry Creek Vista and 1 mile from the Devil's Bridge Trailhead.

**Access:** From the junction of Routes SR 89A and SR 179 in Sedona, take SR 89A west through West Sedona to Dry Creek Road. Turn north at the light and continue to FR152 approximately 2.5 miles to FR 152 for Dry Creek Vista parking. To reach the Mescal Trailhead continue on Dry Creek Rd to Long Canyon Road and turn right to the trailhead 0.3 miles from the intersection
